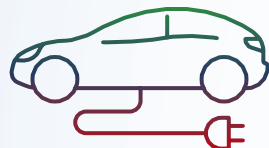

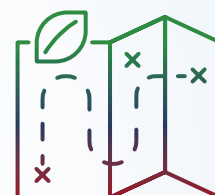

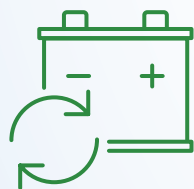
## Environmental Social Governance HIGHLIGHTS 2024
