HOW TO BOOK: Reservations may be made through any AAA Western and Central New York branch or by calling 1-800-937-1222.

SINGLE OCCUPANCY: If a single room must be assigned for any reason, even at the last moment or while on tour, the single room supplement, or prorate thereof, must be collected since hotels make no allowances.

PARKING: If you are picking up AAA transportation at the RIT Inn and Conference Center you will be required to turn in a liability form online prior to your trip for any vehicle left in the lot during the tour. You agree to these terms and conditions when you confirm your trip.

DOCUMENTATION: *NEW!* Beginning May 7, 2025, if you plan to use your state-issued ID or license to fly within the U.S. or to enter a Federal facility, it must be REAL ID compliant or Enhanced. Proper identification and documentation required for cruising and for international travel can vary; please consult your Travel Advisor. Traveling into Canada: All U.S. citizens 16 years of age and older MUST present a valid U.S. Passport, Passport Card, or Enhanced Driver's License for travel into Canada. Photocopies are not acceptable. Children under 16 years of age will need to have a current passport, passport card, or original birth certificate with raised seal. If you are traveling with a child under 16 years of age and are not the legal parent, you are required by customs to carry a notarized statement granting permission from both the child's parents to enter Canada. If you are a single or married parent and are traveling as a single parent, you are required by customs to carry a notarized statement granting permission from the child's other parent to enter Canada. Note: Any passenger without proper proof at boarding may be refused boarding. Non-U.S. citizens should consult their AAA Travel Counselor for appropriate visa requirements.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 2 / COMFORTABLE: easy pace; some stairs and standing; short duration walks typically on level terrains. (including independently boarding/disembarking motorcoach).

ACTIVITY LEVEL 3 / ACTIVE: moderate pace; good mobility needed; stairs and prolonged standing for more than 2 hours at a time; some longer days involving early mornings and/or late evenings; some walking on varied terrain. This Activity Level is not recommended for travelers with mobility issues such as someone who uses a cane, walker, or wheelchair.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 4 / CHALLENGING: fast pace; frequent physically challenging activities; walking on varied terrain and/or up to two miles at a time; longer tour days. This Activity Level is not recommended for travelers with serious medical conditions.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 5 / STRENUOUS: vigorous pace; frequent strenuous activities; extensive walking; longer tour days; walking on varied terrain.

Check into your hotel for your **two-night stay** in Seattle, WA.

Arrive for the **Future of Flight Aviation Center & Boeing Tour**. Watch the world's largest jets assembled in the world's largest building by volume. Begin in the Boeing Theater by viewing an amazing film about how the Boeing Everett aircraft assembly plant has changed the world.

Enjoy lunch on your own at the **Seattle Center Food Hall**, which is a site of the 1962 World's Fair.

After lunch, have an experience high above Seattle in the world-famous **Space Needle**.

There will also be time to wander through the **Chihuly Garden and Glass**. The world-famous Northwest glass artist, Dale Chihuly, presents a comprehensive collection of his work in an Exhibition Hall, a Garden installation, and a Glasshouse.

Next, stop at **Pike Place Market**, the oldest continuously operating market in the United States. You will have time to shop and have dinner on your own at this fascinating multi-level bazaar, where you can buy anything from an old clock to an octopus.

Enjoy an included hotel **breakfast** at your leisure.

Travel to Vancouver Island aboard the 300-seat high speed Victoria Clipper via the Puget Sound and the Strait of Jaun de Fuca. **Proper documentation is required to enter Canada.**

Upon arrival in Victoria, you'll see the city's highlights including the Parliament Building, Beacon Hill Park, and the historic downtown waterfront area.

Next, travel to the world-famous **Butchart Gardens**. Explore more than 35 acres of beautiful flowers and exotic plants. Enjoy the Sunken Garden, scenically placed in an abandoned rock quarry. You will also see gardens laid out in Japanese, Italian, and European styles.

Return to downtown Victoria, where the remainder of the afternoon is free. Lunch and dinner will be on your own today.

In the evening, make your way back to the hotel in Port Angeles, WA.

Enjoy a unique experience as you visit a true-temperate rain forest. Travel to the **Hoh Rain Forest**, for an easy hike on the Hall of Mosses Trail. Here the trees may be more than 1,000 years old, and every surface of the tree, living or dead, is covered with plant life.

After this, depart for **Ocean Shores**, the perfect destination for fun and relaxation. This charming ocean city is known for its long Pacific beach and fresh seafood.

Check into your hotel for a **one-night stay** in Ocean Shores, WA.

Thursday, July 24, 2025

Enjoy an included hotel **breakfast** at your leisure before check-out.

Today visit a great marvel, **The Astoria Column**. Astoria, Oregon is both a gateway and the hub in a region steeped in history. Dedicated by the Great Northern Railway in 1926, the Astoria Column stands today as a monument to those people that dealt with the hardships, bravery, and awe experienced by the first people to live in this corner of the world. The Column is a unique work of Northwest art offering an unparalleled view of the meeting of many roads.

Lunch is on your own today.

After some exploration, you will travel to **Fort Clatsop National Historic Park**, the site where the 33-member Lewis and Clark Expedition wintered from December 7, 1805, until March 23, 1806. The facility includes the reconstructed fort, a visitor center/museum, historical exhibits, canoe landing, spring and trails through the rainforest (young Sitka spruce and western hemlock) of the park.

Dinner is on your own tonight.

Check into the hotel for a **one-night stay** in Seaside, OR.

Friday, July 25, 2025

Enjoy an included hotel **breakfast** at your leisure before check-out.

This morning, travel along the fabulous **Pacific Ocean** and the incredible **Oregon Coast**. The road dips and weaves along craggy cliffs with driftwood beaches and rock promontories stretching for miles. Today's highlights include a lunch on your own in Tillamook, Oregon's leading dairy producing region and home of the West's largest cheese factory, **Tillamook Cheese Factory**.

From here you will head to **Evergreen Aviation and Space Museum**. Discover more than 150 aircraft, spacecraft, and exhibits that tell the story of flight and space exploration with unique historic artifacts, including American aviation icon the Spruce Goose, SR-71 Blackbird, and the Titan II Space Launch Vehicle with its original launch room.

Your next stop is **Red Ridge Farms & Oregon Olive Mill**. The property is surrounded by olive groves and mills, lavender fields, a garden nursery, tasting room and stunning views of surrounding vineyards. Red Ridge Farms is a 135-acre oasis of agricultural crops, natural green space, and eclectic gardens. Take a break from wine tasting to hike their nature trail or wander Penny Durant's herb knot garden and rows of fragrant lavender.
